STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

- A. Students shall comply with professional standards of practice as they pursue their courses, certificates, and degrees.

- F. Students shall provide honest, accurate and truthful documentation for any and all information he or she is required to provide to the UW DEOHS Continuing Education Programs/or OSHA.
- G. Students shall wear name badges for all courses for security reasons. Badges should be worn and visible at all times. (For Seattle courses only)
