The University of Washington, Pacific NW OSHA Education Center and Continuing Education Programs, offers professional development courses to strengthening of occupational safety skills and continuing education. Course participants are expected to follow a code of conduct with honesty and integrity. This professional development course is offered as a synchronous, distance learning course with a facilitated live discussion session. The course is designed to provide participants with practical application 'Teach Back' workshop exercises in small group review.

One of the benefits of course delivery via Live Online Discussion is that course materials and electronic files will be made available for participant review in advance. Course Participant Manuals will be mailed to the location of your virtual classroom or specified telework site. Other course materials will be sent in electronic format via email in advance of course initiation and/or at course conclusion.

The live sessions will cover all OSHA learning objectives using a face-to-face classroom-like format, streaming live using Zoom Pro webinar platform. Online teleconferencing, with active windows for each course participant, will be used as the platform to cover key discussion topics in a conversational style. Each individual enrolled in the course is expected to actively participate by contributing to discussions, answering questions, participating with small group workshop activities, individual telework site activities, and virtual classroom exercises.

Participants are to honor the live virtual classroom code of active contribution throughout the 4-hour session. Course participant teleconference windows should remain 100% active. Windows need to show each individual in their telework site without the use of avatars or icons or JPG images.

Periodic breaks will be provided following classroom-like course format. Participant time away and window idle time will be automatically monitored by teleconference platform.
